### Weekly Color Project Programs @ All Three Locations

<u>Radiant Red!</u> Our take-home project is creating a giant cardboard pizza slice: you can add sauce, cheese, pepperonis, even googly eyes! Everyone will make an oversize flower to add to an enormous vase for the group art project.

<u>Yay for Yellow!</u> We are working with yellow air-dry clay to create a sun-face sculpture to take home, and coloring our traced handprints in warm colors to create a sunburst group mural.
